SUBJECT: GEORGIA'S INTERSTATE PETITIONS AND CORRESPONDENCE

The Georgia Office of Child Support Enforcement has notified the California Department of Child Support Services that all interstate petitions should be sent to their Central Registry, and not to their Family Support Registry. Their Family Support Registry is their state disbursement unit.

All incoming interstate petitions must be sent to:

Correspondence:

Once Georgia's Central Registry has sent the acknowledgement letter back to the initiating jurisdiction, all correspondence should be directed to the local office in Georgia. The Central Registry of Georgia should be contacted if the initiating state does not know the address of the local office or if the Georgia local office has failed to respond to status requests.
