SUBJECT: FEDERAL GRANTS OPPORTUNITY

The Administration for Children and Families (ACF), Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) has announced the 2010 Section 1115 Demonstration Grants. Section 1115(a) of the Social Security Act provides OCSE with authority to fund demonstration grants. Only state title IV-D agencies or the state umbrella agencies of which they are a part are eligible to apply for these grants. There are four grant announcements entitled:

1. Project to Avoid Increasing Delinquencies (PAID) through Collaborations with Other Agencies or Programs
2. How OCSE Grantees Can Support "Building Assets for Fathers and Families" (BAFF)
3. Projects to Support Collaborations with Veterans Affairs
4. Projects to Address Child Support Needs of Active Duty Military Members

The basic procedures for submitting conceptual proposals and grant applications will remain the same as in previous years. LCSAs must submit a concept proposal (see attachment) to their Regional Administrator by Friday, July 2, 2010. DCSS will review the concept proposals and then provide support letters for proposals as necessary.

The due date for submitting completed proposals to OCSE is July 23, 2010. More information on this grant opportunity is available at <http://www.acf.hhs.gov/grants/open/foa/office/ocse>.

All applicants must have a D & B Data Universal Numbering System (D-U-N-S) number. The D-U-N-S number is required whether an applicant is submitting a paper application or using the government wide electronic portal, Grants.gov. A D-U-N-S number is required for every application for a new award or renewal/continuation of an award, including applications or plans under formula, entitlement, and block grant programs. Electronic submission via [www.Grants.gov](http://www.Grants.gov)

- Applicants must be an Authorized Organization Representative (AOR) for their organization and must have a current registration with the Central Contractor Registry (CCR). The CCR registration must be updated annually. Electronically submitted applications will not pass the validation check at Grants.gov if the AOR does not have a current CCR registration and electronic signature credentials.

#### Hard Copy submission

- Applicants submitting their application in paper format should submit one original and two copies of the complete application with all attachments. The original copy of the application must have original signature(s).
