SUBJECT: PROJECT SAVE OUR CHILDREN--SUSPENSION OF NEW REFERRALS

The federal Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE) recently announced that changes were being developed to the process for submitting cases for Federal Criminal Prosecution and Enhanced Locate Service under Project Save Our Children (PSOC). OCSE requests for states to *temporarily suspend* new PSOC referrals (all types) to the PSOC Investigative Analysts. As a result, Local Child Support Agencies (LCSA) are asked to discontinue referring cases to PSOC until further notice. The PSOC suspension applies to referrals for both federal criminal prosecution or enhanced locate. Further direction to the LCSAs will be provided once OCSE finalizes changes to the PSOC process and procedures.
