SUBJECT: PROCEDURES FOR SENDING CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS TO
SWITZERLAND - UPDATED

The purpose of this letter is to provide the local child support agencies (LCSAs) with updated payment processing instructions for Switzerland. It also replaces EBLAST 13-11, dated September 4, 2013 in which the LCSAs were instructed to make all disbursements payable to the custodial party (CP) but mailed to the Switzerland Federal Office of Justice, Central Authority for International Maintenance Matters.

Please be advised, the Swiss authorities recently informed the Department of Child Support Services (DCSS), that the Swiss bank will no longer accept checks sent to the Switzerland Federal Office of Justice and made payable to the (CP). The Swiss Central Authority requests that all future payments be made payable and sent "...directly to the payment address indicated in the application (different in each case)." This is consistent with the *Switzerland Correspondence and Payment Processing Information* provided by the federal Office of Child Support Enforcement, which can be accessed at the following link:
