SUBJECT: PROCEDURES FOR SENDING CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENTS TO IRELAND – UPDATE

This E-Blast supersedes E-Blast 13-09 dated May 28, 2013 and provides the local child support agencies (LCSAs) with updated payment processing instructions for Ireland.

Ireland recently informed the Office of Child Support Enforcement (OCSE), that while case correspondence should still be sent to the Irish Central Authority, child support payments should be sent in accordance with the instructions provided in the order/case. Typically orders direct payments to the custodial parent (CP). If the order does not indicate that payments should be sent to the CP, they should be sent through the Irish Central Authority at the following address:
